- A. The ultimate fulfillment of Enoch's prophesy-ungodliness & judgment at Christ's coming Jude 14, 15
 - 1. Ungodly men unawares (sidewise)
 - a. ?

- b. The revival under Enos 4:26 (Enoch walked with God 5:22, 23)
- c. Enoch's prophecy Jude 14, 15
 - i. Judgement upon ungodliness at the second coming of Jesus Christ
 - ii. God would also judge the ungodliness festering in Enoch's day
- 2. In the days of Enoch's great grandson, Noah, matters came to a head.
 - a. Ungodliness had taken over completely. God out & ungodliness in 6:5-7
 - b. Only Noah's family
- 3. God acted in awful judgement II Peter 2:5
